
FREQUENT INSPECTIONS

- Routine operational checks to identify defects before they affect safety or productivity. Includes inspection of operating mechanisms, hooks, wire ropes, brakes, controls, limit switches, and hydraulic or pneumatic components.




PERIODIC INSPECTIONS

- Detailed examination of mechanical, structural, and electrical components. Evaluates wear, deformation, corrosion, loose or damaged parts, brake condition, controllers, and structural integrity across all major crane systems.



MAINTENANCE INSPECTIONS

- Full mechanical, electrical, and structural review performed at OSHA-defined intervals based on service conditions and operating environment. Includes engineered reporting and recommendations.



BELOW-THE-HOOK INSPECTIONS

- Inspection of slings, chains, lifting beams, spreader bars, and coil hooks for damage, markings, correct construction, and compliance. Additional NDT testing available.

HOOK & WIRE ROPE INSPECTIONS

- Assessment of hooks, attachment components, wire rope wear, deformation, cracks, broken wires, and reeving compliance. Includes written recommendations and optional NDT.
